
This place usually has them for about \$110 and will ship to you.

- 1. Disconnect battery
- 2. Remove the plastic shroud over the alternator.
- 3. Loosen the nut on the left side pulley.
- 4. Loosen the tension bolt and remove the belt. (Counter clockwise is loosening the tension)
- 5. Buy and new Alternator belt
- 6. Disconnect the connection at the top left of the alternator
- 7. Unplug the tan plug in the back left side of the alternator. (there is a little clip that holds it in place.)
- 8. Remove both bolts that hold alternator on
- 9. One on left side and one on the right. (Those are the only 2 holding it in place
- 10. Grab a hold of the alternator and rotate up and down until it comes loose.

Then reverse the procedure to replace.
